Transport is a critical service that enables people to move around our communities safely and quickly as they go about their daily lives. At present our transport system is car centric which puts a high cost on individuals and their families and leaves a lot of our community behind. There are many negative results in our community from our current transport systems and the lack of public transport options.

Around 25% of our population do not have a car licence and are restricted in their transport options. Increasing house and rent prices puts more financial pressure on families and pushes some families to the edge of our community. Lack of public transport compounds these issues.

Horizons Regional Council is the body responsible for delivering public transport to our community and as an elected Councillor and representative of the Horowhenua I am keen to build more support for improvements to our public transport network.

I'm wanting to better understand what the public transport needs of our community are and the impact of having limited transport options.

- Bus from Levin to Palmerston North Monday and Wednesday in the morning and returning in the afternoon.
- Bus from Levin to Waikanae Tuesday and Thursday in the morning and returning in the afternoon.
- Around town bus from Levin, Shannon, Foxton, Foxton Beach, Waitarere Beach on Friday morning and returning on Friday afternoon.
